KIT LIST

Course: CS40 Chainsaws – Aerial Tree Pruning

Trainees need to bring:

- Top Handled Chainsaw
- *Appropriate clothing:* climbing helmet with visor and ear protection; chainsaw trousers (Type C); chainsaw boots with ankle support; gloves (rigging, sailing or latex work gloves)
- *Ropes:* Two tree climbing ropes (37-45m); rigging rope (13-22mm, 60m); split tail (13mm, 5m)
- *Slings:* 1 anchor sling; 3 dead eye sling; 3 endless loop slings
- Rescue knife and large dressing bandage
- Tree climbing harness
- 4 Prussik Loops
- 7 Karabiners including 3 oval and 3 triple-locking
- 1 positioner
- 1 pair climbing spikes
- 1 throw line and throw weight
- 1 multi saver
- Tool Loop
- Hand saw (e.g. Silky)
- Chainsaw maintenance equipment
- Porta wrap / bollard & ratchet strap
- Rigging block / 2 pulleys

All equipment must be either less than 6 months old or have passed a LOLER check, evidence of this will be required on the first day

NB If you are providing facilities or equipment, please ensure that the requirements of the Health & Safety at Work Act and any relevant regulations are met.
